088	Apologies An apology had been received from Cllr Fox due to illness. Resolved to accept this apology
089	Declarations of Interest Cllr T Greenshields declared an interest in a payment being made to him.
090	Minutes The Minutes of the meeting held on the 17 th September 2019, having been previously circulated, were adopted as a true record.
091	Matters Arising Cllr T Greenshields informed the meeting that he had been advised by our solicitor that the registering of the Rope Walk would be difficult because we were tenants rather than owners of the Playfield. The Solicitor would however write one more letter regarding the matter to Land Registry.
092	Police Report A short report had been circulated prior to the meeting which was noted.
093	County and District Report The District councillor informed the meeting that he would circulate his report. He went on to speak about the refusal of a power station application in the Woodbury area and another planning application in the Yarcombe/Membury area. The proposal to increase car parking charges in East Devon has been referred back to the cabinet. He concluded by talking about the possibility of a Dorset and East Devon National Park Our County Councillor will assist with £50 towards a tree planting scheme. A number of highway seminars have been arranged in Devon with the emphasis on working with town and parish councils. Axminster council had purchased some pothole repair materials which can be purchase at a very reasonable price. A report had also been circulated.
