<b>190</b>	<b>Apologies</b> An apology was noted from PCSO Widger
<b>191</b>	<b>Declarations of Interest</b> No Declarations of Interest under the Code of Conduct were made at the stage of the meeting.
<b>192</b>	<b>Minutes</b> The Minutes of the Council meeting held on the 21 <sup>st</sup> June 2016 were adopted as a true record
<b>193</b>	<b>Matters Arising</b> There were no matters arising.
<b>194</b>	<b>County Report</b> Cllr A Moulding informed the meeting that he was having a meeting with the Head of Safety for the Police on the 1 <sup>st</sup> August regarding signage and average speed signs at Hunters Lodge. The traffic lights at Weycroft Bridge are being replaced in October or November.
<b>195</b>	<b>District Report</b> Cllr I Hall also referred to the need to make some improvements to the Hunter's Lodge road junction.
<b>196</b>	<b>Police Report</b> A police report had been circulated to councillors.
<b>197</b>	<b>Democratic Period</b> There were concerns for the need for a gateway entrance by the school to avoid the need for walking on the road. A comment was made that at the previous meeting, due to the large number of people present, it was difficult to hear what was being said, therefore it was felt that the PA system should

	have been used which would have also opened the loop system.
