Minutes of the Council Meeting held at the Hawkchurch Village Hall on Tuesday 20th November 2018

Present: Cllr's R Churchill (Chairman), D Searle, S Bartlett, T Greenshields, R Fox , J Horrocks and J Baker.

614	Apologies No Apologies received.
615	Declaration of Acceptance of office The Proper Officer declared that Cllr J Horocks had made his Declaration of Acceptance of Office
616	Declarations of Interest There were no Declarations of interest made at this stage of the meeting.
617	Minutes The minutes of the Council meeting held on the 16 th October 2018 were adopted as a true record.
618	Playing Field Minutes The minutes of the committee meeting held on the 16 th October 2018 were adopted as a true record.
619	Matters Arising from the Minutes The meeting noted that the planning application for the community shop and now been passed by EDDC.
620	County and District Report Cllr Hall informed the meeting that EDDC had agreed to take out a loan of 6.7 Million from the Loan Board to enable the north/south relief road in Axminster to go ahead. He stated that this would be a tremendous benefit to the area as it would take large vehicles away from the town centre. A consultation day for the new road scheme will be held on the 6 th December. A new flat rate car parking day charge of £2 was being introduced throughout the East Devon area. Concerns were expressed about the lack of full cash facilities at the refurbished Lloyds Bank in Axminster. At present there are no scheduled dates for the improved Super Broadband in the areas that were not covered by the original scheme. It was hoped that the badgers had now vacated the area that they had damaged on a lane in the parish; which would allow it to be filled in. A question was asked regarding the improvements made last year to the road

	<p>layout at Hunters Lodge. Concerns remained regarding the speed of vehicles even though there was a 40mph speed limit. The other problem was vehicles turning into the Lyme Regis road who get held up behind a bus stopped at the bus stop. He expected the County Council rates to be increased by 2.99%, with a possible additional 1% social care increase being implemented. In concluded by informing the meeting that Flybe had announced that it was putting the business up for sale. With this in mid EDDC was looking at assisting to make sure that there was a buyer for the company.</p>
621	<p>Democratic Period A parishioner was concerned that there was very little publicity regarding the possibility of extended the AONB area. It was agreed that this item would be placed on the December agenda. It was also felt that the need for the parish to produce a Neighbourhood Plan should be re-examined. This was also agreed to be placed on the agenda of the next meeting.</p>
622	<p>Accounts for Payment The following accounts were agreed for payment: Lottery Wins £75, Websafe £50, Darren Strawbridge £445 and A Down £75.</p>
623	<p>Financial Update The financial update of budget v actual had been circulated prior to the meeting, and was adopted</p>
624	<p>Budget and Precept Demand 2019/20 It was resolved that the budget for 2019/20 would be £14,000 and that the precept demand would be £10,000; the same as this year. The RFO would make some alterations to the figures as it understood that the Playfield revenue would be less than he had anticipated.</p>
625	<p>Planning Applications Nil</p>
626	<p>Planning Determinations 18/2071/Ful South Ridge, Blackpool Corner for a single storey extension has been approved 18/2098/Full Community Shop. Erection of timber building has been approved.</p>
627	<p>Highways Lengthsman will undertake work in the parish on the 30th November, and a day in December and January. Some duplication of work had recently been experienced. Gritbins need to be checked to ensure they are full for the winter. Cllr Searle authorised to deal with clearing of snow in the parish if the need arises.</p>
628	<p>Rights of Way The new bridge of footpath 16 is hoped to be put in position next week. A stile has been repaired on footpath 39 and barbed wire dealt with on footpath 48.</p>
